CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBILITIES INFORMATION

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions and adherence to responsibilities

1. Disclaimer

The completion and signing of the Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement is a Condition of Entry to The Mitavite IDSHS (Aust) Inc. Irish Draught and Irish Sport Horse National Breed Show Spectacular 2018. You will not be allowed to enter the Event Venue if you have not completed and signed a Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement.

2. Helmet and boots

All riders must wear currently approved helmets and boots whilst mounted. Any breach of this rule may lead to disqualification.

3. Appropriate Footwear and Uneven Surfaces

It is advised that everyone attending The Mitavite IDSHS (Aust) Inc. Irish Draught and Irish Sport Horse National Breed Show Spectacular 2018 ensure that they are wearing appropriate footwear for the type and condition of the walking surfaces likely to be encountered within a Venue of this type. It is an outdoor Venue that has varying and undulating surfaces, you are advised to take all due care when travelling on foot.

4. Car Parking

Please observe a speed limit of 10km/h when driving your vehicle to and from your chosen parking space and ensure that you:

Observe the movement of horse and human traffic in the car park area to avoid a collision

When parking your car, horse float or horse transport vehicle please ensure that you:

- Allow sufficient space between your vehicle and others to ensure that the potential for damage or injury to occur as a result of the behaviour of you, your horse/s or another's horse is reduced.
- Allow sufficient space for the loading and unloading of your horse/s from your float or horse transport to minimise any danger of damage to cars, collision with cars or the injury of any person or horse not directly involved in the activity of loading or unloading your horse.

5. Securing of Horses

It is your sole responsibility to ensure that your horse/s are restrained in a safe and responsible manner at all times.

6. Horse Accommodation

Should you be utilising/hiring the yards, it is your responsibility to inspect the facilities being offered and satisfy yourself that the yard is in the condition you are happy with before you place your horse/s or yourself within its confines. Should you be unhappy with the yard provided, it is your responsibility to advise an appropriate IDSHS (Aust) Inc. representative that you wish to use an alternative stable.

7. Participant Responsibilities

As a Participant in the Event it is essential that you acknowledge that horses are an independent animal, capable of erratic and explosive actions that have the potential to cause harm to humans, property and other horses despite the best endeavours of the Competitors and Event Organisers.



(7. Continued)

To this end all **Participants in the Event need to ensure that their behaviour does not contribute or cause in any way an event resulting the injury of people or horse/s or damage to property.**

As a guide avoid the following behaviours:

- Sudden and exaggerated movements
- Waving of items such as plastic bags or cloth
- Generation of loud or unusual noises
- Use of equipment unexpectedly i.e. Flash cameras

8. Pedestrian Entrance to the Arenas

When not competing or presenting a horse/s all pedestrians entering the Arenas must use due care and acknowledge that the entrances will also be used for entry by horses and competitors for the purpose of entering the Arenas to participate in Competition. In addition pedestrians are to avoid standing in any mustering areas outside a Competition Arena.

9. Remain Alert and Mindful

When moving in and around the Venue and the Competition Arena it is your responsibility to **remain alert and mindful of the movement of horses and cars in and around the Venue.**

10. Scratching

No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. All refunds will have an administration fee of \$10.00 deducted.

11. Changes to program

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

12. Inclement weather

The Mitavite IDSHS (Aust) Inc. Irish Draught and Irish Sport Horse National Breed Show Spectacular 2018 is an outdoor event and participants must prepare for the effect of forecast weather. If this event is cancelled due to extreme weather conditions all relevant information will be posted on the IDSHS (AUS) INC. web site, Facebook page and Event Secretary web site.

13. Removal of manure

Shibumi Equestrian centre requests that all competitors take to the manure to the manure area.

14. Dogs
